Your Role as a Mentor:

- Provide professional guidance to 1-2 aspiring APIA professionals
- At least 1 virtual meeting per month between April and October
- Log all meetings on the Mentor Collective platform
- Attend a 1-hour virtual training
- Complete program surveys in July and October

Mentor Eligibility:

Bachelor's degree or higher OR 5 years of work experience

Resources will be provided and APIA Scholars staff are available to support you.
