- 1) Recent CV or Resume
- 2) One- to two-page cover letter outlining the following:
 - Why you are interested in the fellowship program
 - How your experience and skills will enable you to contribute to the project's success
 - How this program will support your professional development and goals.
- 3) Short Essay (400 words) with the following components:
 - Please examine an existing piece of research in any of the following topics (Anti-Asian Hate & AANHPI Racism, Civic Engagement & Leadership, English Learners, Mental Health & Wellbeing) on the AANHPI community that you found persuasive, impactful, or missing an important perspective or showing a critical gap of knowledge about our community.
 - Identify recipients that can benefit most from this research and stakeholders who have the potential to affect meaningful change for AANHPI students.
 - Please include a citation for the work that you reference. The citation will not count toward the word limit. (400-word limit)

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Currently enrolled Graduate Student, all majors are welcome to apply; strong preference for those pursuing graduate degrees in Education, Policy, or degrees related to research themes
- Self Identifies as Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander (AANHPI)
- Demonstrated technical skills in research methods, data collection, data entry, database management, demonstrated experience in SPSS or other statistical software (e.g. R, STATA, SAS), and strong data analysis and writing skills
- Some knowledge about, or experience working on, issues related to the AANHPI community in the following areas: Anti-Asian Hate & AANHPI Racism, Civic Engagement & Leadership, English Learners, and Mental Health & Wellbeing
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills and ability to work well within a team environment
